The Pinaymootang Health Centre is an accredited health run facility and is seeking applications for three (3) one-year full time term positions of Resource Workers (RWs) under its new pilot project for Adults with the Intellectual Developmental Exceptionalities Program. To provide services and resources to individuals and their families living with intellectual and developmental exceptionalities on reserve.

The Resource Workers (WRW) under the Adults with Intellectual and Developmental Exceptionalities Program (AIDE) will provide supports to adults and their families living with intellectual and developmental Exceptionality on reserve.

#### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Engage adults with exceptionalities to ensure on and off reserve supports to improve health and to participate in daily activities at home, at school and in the community because of significant impairments in one or more of the following areas: Health, Cognition, Communication, Sensory-motor skills, social integration, Emotion/behavioral skills, and Self-help skills for independent living.
- Initiate Adult Day Programs that are a set of services that work to improve the quality of life of people who are living with exceptionalities and/or mental health issues. The Adult Day Program will offer a balance between work experience opportunities, recreational activities, educational programming, life skills training based on our customary ways of life.
- Programming will use a person-centered approach meaning we take the time to build relationships with people and follow their direction in reaching goals and interests, making them central to the supports they receive.

#### **Qualifications:**

- Excellent time management skills
- Highly-motivated team player who is innovative and creative; has a proven ability to work with a very high degree of accuracy and attention to detail
- Available to work irregular hours on occasion
- Ability to function under pressure and use tact, diplomacy and good judgment
- Ability to work independently, make appropriate timely decisions and act as required
- Ability to maintain a high level of confidentiality
- Must have a valid driver's licence
- Knowledge and understanding of First Nations Culture and Language would be an asset
